Empire Runners December 17, 2009 Club Meeting

(pending approval at the January 2010 meeting)

Vice President Nate Koch called the December, 2009 meeting to order at 6:35 pm.

Secretary's Report:

Secretary Paul Berg read the November 2009 meeting minutes which were approved as read.

Treasurers's Report:

Treasurer John Harmon reported that the current club balance is \$41,840.28, up \$10,382 from the same time last year.

The major expense in the past month was \$7200 for Kenwood t-shirts.

McGuire's Breakfast Run had a \$125 profit vs. 109 last year.

XC team expense for 2009 is \$2880 vs. \$2825 for 2008.

The Student Grant Fund balance is \$1021.

Race Reports:

1. Recent races/Runs:

- 2. Wild Turkey Ramble 11/26/09 turkeys were sighted
- 3. McGuire's Breakfast Run 11/29/09 Mike McGuire reported 30 participants in each race. John Anderson did timing. Usual prizes, plus 3 gift certificates from Tag's deli. (proposal to donate profits to HV school below, new business)
- 4. CIM 12/6/09 several Empire runners. Shirley Fee reported that the relay race was very disorganized and not enough outhouses at aid stations.

2. Upcoming Races/Runs:

- 1. Last 10k & Final 2mi 12/19/09 Large number of pre-registered, big turnout expected. John Anderson needs registration help starting at 8am. Bob Shor reported that there will be staggered start times: 10k at 9:00am, 2 mi at 9:05am.
- 2. Jingle Bell Run (12/22/09) Rob and Shelli Main's House (5063 Eliggi Court, Santa Rosa) meet 6pm, run 6:30pm. Potluck after.
- 3. Resolution Run 1/1/10 Gil needs volunteers for membership booth. Val needs 6-8 people for registration help.
- 4. Club Party 2/6/10 Val Sell reported that Tagliaferi's Deli will be doing pasta this year, anticipating the half-marathon the following morning. Val will need help decorating the hall at 5pm that day.
- 5. Grand Prix donations/gift certificates. Bob Rogers discussed changes in race results reporting to facilitate Grand Prix results. He proposed that there should be a checkbox on race entry forms and/or race tags to easily determine if someone is a member. Steve Rausch is working on the database to make sorting results easier.

Grand Prix awards for 2009 winners: Bob Rogers proposed that age group awards in the amount of \$ 25-20-15 gift certificates to FleetFeet. If an individual wants to sponsor an age group, they may reimburse the club for the \$60, but all age groups will receive gift certificates. The 6 overall awards will be provided by

This problem became apparent in the attempt to re-order womens's running bras. A committee was formed to ponder the issue.
- 4. Training Run Oversight. Larry Meredith agreed to continue oversight of the various training group schedules. With the addition of the Petaluma training group and the anticipated Heart&Sole group lead by Kenny Brown, the website has been updated to include all the group information.
