Treasurers' Report:

Treasurer Tanya Narath (treasurer@empirerunners.org) reported that the total club balance is \$63,552, which includes \$10,843 for Annadel Half restricted funds, and \$2711 Student Grant Fund restricted funds.

Not including restricted funds; the current balance is \$49,999, compared to \$33,914 last year.
