# Empire Runners May 27, 2010 Club Meeting

President Nate Koch (<u>president@empirerunners.org</u>) called the May 2010 meeting to order at 7:33 pm.

#### Secretary's Report:

Secretary Paul Berg (<u>secretary@empirerunners.org</u>) read the April 22 meeting minutes which were approved as read.

#### **Treasurers's Report:**

Treasurer John Harmon (<u>treasurer@empirerunners.org</u>) was absent, Paul Berg reported: Checking balance is \$25,704.95 Wild Apricot Account balance is \$1,796.72 Total club funds are \$26,290.59, which is \$746 higher than the same time last year. Student Grant Fund balance is \$2,375. High School donations Year-to-date are \$1,885. Projection of total 2010 donations equaling \$5,705 Race Financials: Heart & Sole Elite Mile will net \$0. \$200 still owed by H&S to ER Loop de Loop financials are not complete. Will report next month Jack Rabbit Derby lost \$98 vs. \$0 last year. Expenses were up from previous years. 2009 all proceeds were donated. Kenwood expenses-to-date are \$8,967 with \$494 in race entries. Wild Apricot will present some bookkeeping challenges in order to track membership and race entries, but we should have a good process for that by June.

Val Sell presented a proposal to increase the contribution to the Kenwood Community Church pancake Breakfast. Val explained that the parade will not be happening this year, so the footrace is the only attraction. There was discussion of what the church provides for the logistics of the footrace. Sentiment was expressed that we need to keep the town happy with the event to ensure their continued support. There was discussion also of how the breakfast discount, subsidized by ER, is advertised to the runners. Val had originally thought to cap the donation at \$1000, but this was thought to discriminate against slower finishers. It was agreed to NOT cap the donation this year. Estimated cost to the Empire Runners would increase from \$360 to \$900 for this donation. Proposal:

I, Val Sell, propose that the Empire Runners increase the donation to the Kenwood Community Church for the Pancake Breakfast from \$2 to \$5 for a registered runner for the Kenwood Footrace for 2010.
